On February 26, 2010, the first of many students graduated from the Extension Campus. Thirty-three students received their diplomas, with over thirty more working toward next year's graduation.

It was a thrilling moment for all of us! We have watched the students over the past few years and seen them persevere through hardships and obstacles that are unknown in the West, and step up to a higher level. One student walked 3 hours to get to a cart drawn by a water buffalo to ride 3 hours to get to a bus to travel another 4 hours to get to school! His story of commitment to study God's Word is not out of the ordinary for these extraordinary people.



Many testimonies have come from the students of how the knowledge of the Word of God they learned at the EC has impacted both their lives and ministries. Most importantly, many are being saved as the students share the Gospel. One testimony of healing came from a student with an obstructed

nasal passage; the doctor told him surgery was the only answer, but the student could not afford the surgery. During his training, God completely healed him and he no longer needs surgery. His wife was often ill before she began attending school. As she studied the Word of God, she learned that God still heals today, it is God's will to heal, and that she can be healed. Her faith became strong, and she is no longer frequently ill, but is now strong and healthy.



Special thanks goes to one man whose vision and commitment propelled the school forward because of his unrelenting commitment for the leaders under his care to be trained and equipped in the Word of God, with the Full Gospel, & Word of Faith.

1 John 5:4 says, "This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith." The believers here face exceptional challenges and obstacles. Being equipped with the Word of Faith is a life or death issue for them. Thank you for helping them!
