The new school year has begun... again! We are excited about the 42 students who are training with us. Eleven of these students come from other nations: Myanmar, Africa, and Nagaland. We have had many other international students through the years too: from Macau, Singapore, Australia, Philippines, China, and even Poland! We also have Thai students who now reside outside of Thailand and are being a witness of Jesus Christ where they are. So the Gospel is going out from Rhema Thailand into the far reaches of the world.

It is not just students going out into the far reaches of the world, Keith & Sharon recently traveled outside Thailand to teach a people hungry to know God, understand His Word, and enthusiastic for training to help others.
